

VILLAGE OF WILCOX

BYLAW NO. 2/93

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF BYLAWS OF THE VILLAGE OF WILCOX
PURSUANT TO SECTION 92 OF THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1984

The Council of the Village of Wilcox in the Province of Saskatchewan,
enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. In this bylaw the expression "municipality" means the Village of Wilcox, of the Province of Saskatchewan.
3. Section 4 of this bylaw shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw which provides for the penalties provided in this bylaw, and for which no other penalty is provided.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 3 of this bylaw, any person who contravenes any provision of a bylaw of the municipality passed pursuant to The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 shall be liable to a fine of not more than:
 - (i) \$2,000 in the case of an individual;
 - (ii) \$5,000 in the case of a corporation
5. Any person who contravenes a bylaw of the municipality shall, unless otherwise provided in such bylaw, pay all penalties and fines to the Clerk of the municipality, and on such payment that person is not liable to prosecution for having contravened said bylaw, and all such payments shall belong to and form part of the general revenue of the municipality.
